The Powhatan County Electoral Board met on April 20, 2021 at 11:00 to perform the Logic & Accuracy Testing of the voting equipment for the June Democratic Primary. Following the testing, Frank Flannagan suggested that the Electoral Board meet to review and approve the meeting minutes from the November General Election Canvas on 11/04/2020 & 11/06/2020 and well as the 12/09/2020 Electoral Board Meetings.

The meeting was called to order at 2:25 PM. The previous meeting minutes were approved. There was a discussion surrounding the Catholic Dioceses of Richmond's recent agreement to allow voting to return to their facilities. Both Blessed Sacrament Huguenot Catholic School and St. John Neumann Catholic Church have agreed to serve as official voting precincts once again. Frank Flannagan moved to have Precinct 103/Flat Rock return to St John Neumann Catholic Church (located at 2480 Batterson Road, Powhatan, VA 23139) from its temporary relocation of Powhatan High School (located at 1800 Judes Ferry Road). Combined in the same motion was the recommendation to return Precinct 301/Bethesda to Blessed Sacrament Huguenot Catholic School (located at 2501 Academy Road) from its temporary relocation of Red Lane Baptist Church (located at 2095 Red Lane Road). Andrea Weber seconded that motion and all agreed.

Discussion surrounding the third precinct relocation ensued and a motion was made by Andrea Weber to maintain the relocated placement of Precinct 401/Courthouse located at Powhatan Middle School (located at 4135 Old Buckingham Road). The motion was seconded by Josephine Goodman and all agreed. It was in unanimous agreement that the Electoral Board felt that the size and lack of parking at Company 1 Fire Department no longer fit the needs of the largest precinct in the County.

Vice Chair Goodman moved to adjourn the meeting. All voted in favor. The meeting was adjourned by Mr. Flannagan at 2:30 PM.
