

NOTICE UNDER THE AMERICANS WITH DISABILITIES ACT

POWHATAN COUNTY RIDE ASSIST SERVICES

In accordance with the requirements of Title II of the Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990 (ADA), POWHATAN COUNTY RIDE ASSIST SERVICES will not discriminate against qualified individuals with disabilities on the basis of disability in its services, programs, or activities.

Employment: POWHATAN COUNTY RIDE ASSIST SERVICES does not discriminate on the basis of disability in its hiring or employment practices and complies with all regulations by the U.S. Equal Employment Opportunity Commission.

Effective Communication: POWHATAN COUNTY RIDE ASSIST SERVICES will generally, upon request, provide appropriate aids and services leading to effective communication for qualified persons with disabilities so they can participate equally in our programs, services, and activities, including qualified sign language interpreters, documents in Braille, and other ways of making information and communications accessible to people who have speech, hearing, or vision impairments.

Modifications to Policies and Procedures: POWHATAN COUNTY RIDE ASSIST SERVICES will make all reasonable modifications to policies and programs to ensure that people with disabilities have an equal opportunity to enjoy all of its programs, services, and activities. Anyone who requires an auxiliary aid or service for effective communication, or a modification of policies or procedures to participate in our program, service, or activity, should contact our ADA Coordinator at 804-598-5630 as soon as possible but no later than 48 hours before the scheduled event.

The ADA does not require POWHATAN COUNTY RIDE ASSIST SERVICES take any action that would fundamentally alter the nature of its programs or services, or impose any undue financial or administrative burden.

Complaints that a POWHATAN COUNTY RIDE ASSIST SERVICES program, service, or activity is not accessible to persons with disabilities should be directed to our ADA Coordinator at 804-598-5630.

POWHATAN COUNTY RIDE ASSIST SERVICES will not place a surcharge on a particular individual with a disability or any group of individuals with disabilities to cover the cost of providing auxiliary aids / services or reasonable modifications of policy.
