The meeting was called to order at 11:34 am.

Nancy Ayers briefed the board and the Director on several items that were discussed at the Boot Camp class she attended this past week. One topic was curbside voting and the other was concealed weapons carry at voting precincts. No action was needed.

Nancy Ayers requested that we do a yearly calendar with dates for meetings and important elections dates.

A discussion was had about the upcoming VEBA conference in March at Hot Springs, Virginia. Karen Alexander stated she had received confirmation for the EB's registrations. Frank Flannagan, Secretary, asked the Director to cancel his registration due to his upcoming surgery.

The Director of Elections informed the board that she had received a request from the Headmaster, Tracy Hamner from Blessed Sacrament Huguenot High School, asking that we find another venue to hold elections. Our last election there will be June 18th.

The Electoral Board along with the Director discussed our options as to where we could move the voting precinct for 301. Frank Flannagan, will talk with Dr. James Taylor, Pastor of Red Lane Baptist Church. He will report on February 28th, at our next meeting. Bill Melton, will talk with someone about the possibility of using the War Memorial Building if we need to move precinct 401 to that location in the future.

The Board went into Recess at 12:40 pm for the purpose of going to Graceland Baptist Church. They had called and said they would be doing renovating during the Presidential Primary.


The Chairwoman, Nancy Ayers called the Electoral Board meeting back to order at 2:20 pm.
