Nancy Ayers, Chairwoman, opened the meeting at 10:01 am

The Director of Election, Karen Alexander, gave a brief discussion to the Board about how the ballots would be identified during the June Dual Primary. An individual voter would state which primary they wished to vote in. The Election Officer would repeat that request back to the voter to assure they were getting the correct ballot.

The Board voted to go into recess for the purpose of visiting the Ballsville Rescue Building to see if could be used as a new voting precinct for Tobaccoville in the November 5th Election.

After a brief discussion about moving the 503/Tobaccoville precinct to the Ballsville Rescue Squad Building, Bill Melton made a motion to proceed with the relocation of the 503/Tobaccoville Precinct to this new location for the following reasons: 1) a safer entrance and exit to Old Buckingham Road, 2) more parking available with handicap spaces identified, and 3) a larger area to hold elections. The Motion was seconded.

The Director of Election was asked to proceed with guidelines required by the VA Dept of Elections to formally and officially move of the precinct and to notify the County for a public hearing.

The next meeting was set for June 10th, to prepare the Director of Election's FY'24 Annual Evaluation.
