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Volunteer's Release from Liability Form

The undersigned being duly aware of the risks and hazards inherent upon entering the said premises and/or in participating in any and all aspects of the operations of PAC at said premises, knowing the current condition, operations, and risks and knowing that these conditions, operations, and risks may become more hazardous and dangerous during the time that the undersigned is upon the said premises, the undersigned hereby voluntarily assumes all risk of loss, damage, or injury, including death, that may be sustained by the undersigned, or any property of the undersigned while in, on, or upon said premises.

The release shall be binding upon the distributes, heirs, next of kin, executors, administrators and personal representatives of the undersigned.

In signing the foregoing release, the undersigned here by acknowledges and represents:

- That they have read the release, understands it, and signs it voluntarily;
- That they are over the age of 18 years old and of sound mind;
- That they are not an agent, employee of the Powhatan Animal Control
