June 18, 2025

The chair called the meeting to order at 9:40 am.

Bill Melton made a motion that the Electoral Board convene into closed session pursuant to Section §24.2-653 (B) of the Code of Virginia for the purpose of considering whether each person who submitted a provisional ballot at the Democratic Primary on June 17, 2025, was qualified to do so. The motion passed 3-0, and the closed session took place.

At 10:05 a.m. the Board came out of closed session. The Board moved that the Electoral Board certify that in the closed session just concluded, the only matters discussed were the qualifications of provisional voters, as identified in the motion to close the meeting pursuant to the Virginia Freedom of Information Act. The motion passed 3-0.

The Electoral Board and Director of Elections moved into canvassing the June 17th Primary Election.

A motion was made and seconded to recess until Monday, June 23rd, at 11:00 a.m. to finalize the canvass and sign abstracts.
